An Overview of SEV

- SEV has been representing the concerns of employees in the public transport sector (railway, local bus transport, navigation, tourist transport services, aviation) since 1919.
- SEV has roughly 40'000 members, including both active and retired workers.
- SEV fights for contemporary working conditions at more than 100 companies and negotiates more than 70 collective labour agreements and company labour agreements.
- The average union density amounts to approximately 50%.
- SEV advocates for reliable and environmentally friendly public services. SEV is independent of any political parties and religious denominations.



SEV in Detail

Collective Services

- SEV negotiates and signs collective labour agreements and company labour agreements as well as agreements on working conditions (holidays, working hours, etc.) and salaries that serve the employees' protection.
- SEV advocates for sustainable and future-oriented transport policies and socio-political issues within the Swiss cantons, but also at national and European levels.




SEV's Democratic Structure

- SEV consists of eight sub-associations and approximately 150 sections. Every member belongs to one section.
- Congress is SEV's highest authority. 250 delegates from sub-associations, sections as well as commissions (youth, women, and migrants) come together every other year to define the goals and basic tenets for SEV's policy. For example, Congress elects the union's executive management and has the authority to add or amend statutes and regulations.
- The managing committee is responsible for SEV's strategic management in the time between two Congress meetings. The committee meets approximately ten times per year. Its 19 members (two from each sub-association and one from each commission) make budgetary and other decisions and elect the union secretaries. Furthermore, the managing committee approves and amends regulations that are not governed by the Congress.
- The four members of the executive management are responsible for SEV's operational management.

SEV's regional offices

The SEV Main Office is located in Bern. SEV has regional offices in all parts of the countries.




